Sub :- Organization of Cluster/State, Regional and National Sports Meet for the year 2018-19 – Reg

Ref :- NVS Hqrs. letter No. 29-3/2018-NVS(ACAD)/114 dt. 23-4-2018.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject cited above, the meeting of Regional Sports Board has been organized at Bhopal on 31st May 2018. After detailed discussion & deliberation, the following decision were taken :-

During the course of meeting the following general decisions were held

- The PETs should select best students only based upon their performance/skill test.
- Sports Captain should be appointed.
- In Athletic, junior student who played at National level should be coached properly.
- House wise game should be conducted by involving HM & AHM. Belongingness should be developed in the students.
- Warm up for the particular games is available in the website and same should be downloaded and followed in true spirit.
- Fair selection of students at cluster, state and Regional level should be made by appointing judges/referees from outside.
- Play ground should be properly developed.

- If possible matron should not be sent for escort duty.
- Efforts should be made by Principals to get Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Wrestling & Judo mat from the District Sports Officer with the help of District Collector. Action taken report in this regard is to be submitted to this office **by 31st July 2018.**
- The Principals should prepare a route chart of their cluster and coordinate with other JNVs to reduce escort duty for participation of students in cluster as well as state level sports meet.
- If possible one teacher should be made incharge for one game as per their interest.
- Extra diet should be provided to the players at Cluster, Regional & National Level.
- The effective involvement of Venue Principal at Regional event.
- PET should boost the confidence among the students.
- Wherever both posts of PETs are vacant the nearby PETs should be deputed on rotational basis. The telephonic permission from the concerned Cluster Incharge Asstt. Commissioner should be obtained.
- Principal, JNV Sambalpur suggested that if possible morning 30 minutes can be utilized for sports, only for those students having skills in sports.
- At Regional participation, it is noticed that during march past some of the students are not wearing specific uniform.
- Participation of JNV team in the District Level/State/National Level may be participated for exposure.
- Sports Equipment should be procured as per SGFI norms.
- Appreciation certificate to the PETs for their best performance will be issued every year.

- ✓ Games & Sports have been a vital component of JNVs since beginning to ensure all round development of student. Games and Sports not only helps to improve academic performance but also act as a powerful tool for promoting leadership, team work skills and social cohesion.
- ✓ Last year Rope Skipping game was introduced in all the JNVs and extended participation at National Level.
- ✓ In view to organize SGFI Championship of Football Under -14 Category by NVS. The competent authority has decided to organize Football Under-14 Boys at Cluster, Regional & National Level hence the team may be selected accordingly.
- ✓ In view of the demand of Girls, Football event for Girls Under - 17 & Under - 19 was introduced last year. The same event will be continued up to National Level.

- ✓ Cricket & Hockey for girls also introduced at JNV level during 2017 - 18 and these events will be continued in 2018-19 upto Regional level only.
- ✓ This year Boxing for Boys & Girls for U-14, 17 & 19 has been introduced upto National Level.

6. Meal during the Cluster/Regional Games

During the games & sports meet in particular venue vidyalaya, expenditure on food will be restricted to the usual norms determined by the venue vidyalaya in keeping with the Samiti norms. But vidyalaya should ensure that good & balanced nourishment provided to the students.

7. Escort and Coaching for National Team

The list of PETs are deputed as escort and coaching duty to the National Team will be issued separately. The venue Principal of Regional event will organize 10-15 days coaching camp by involving outside SAI Coach to develop

stamina and skills among the players before they take part in the National game. **The Principals are directed not to sanction CCL to lady PETs during the period of coaching & escort of National team, if necessary on special ground the permission from the undersigned should be taken.**

8. Other Guidelines/Directions for conduct of Games & Sports

- The Principals should submit result and a brief report of the Cluster/State/Regional & National meet with photographs/CD to this office within 10 days after completion of meet.

- **Selection of Teams**

Selection of players for Regional/National team will be made on the basis of their performance in each game which will be judged by a duly constituted selection committee. The Principal of the venue will be the Chairman of the selection committee including PETs and outside experts. This committee will assess the performance of the students in different games and select only the best students who can make a mark at the Regional & National level Games.

The Principals of the Cluster level venues will make arrangements to send the students to the respective venue of Regional level Games and Athletics. Escort teachers for the Regional Meet will be selected by the Cluster venue Principal. The Cluster venue Principals will provide sports uniform & kit for Regional Meet.

- **Documentation**

Participants are to submit the following documents: -

1. Eligibility form completely filled in with color passport size photograph (1 copy).
2. Photo copy of DOB certificate submitted by the student at the time of admission in present school (1 copy)
3. Medical fitness certificate.
4. Risk certificate by the parents.

- **Measures to be taken for Safety and Security of the students during the meets**

As a large number of activities like Games and Sports, Exhibitions will be taking place and a number of students will be moving from schools to school and also playing in playfields it becomes imperative to take care of safety and security issues. In this context it is requested that the following precautions may be kept in mind to avoid any future complications.

- (a) It may be specially instructed to all the students and the house masters that the children invariably present themselves during the roll call times. Even if the children are pre-occupied in some activities they should invariably report for the roll call personally and then go back to their place

of work. They should report personally to the House Master concerned, otherwise there is a possibility that the children may tend to escape taking advantage of the pre-occupation of the teachers in other activities.

- (b) The Principals should be very careful in choosing teachers for escort duties for the games and sports meets. Only those teachers who are competent and have the desired attitude should be chosen for this task. Clear cut guidelines should be given regarding the safety and security measures to be taken up during the journey and during conduct of the meet.
- (c) During journey time no student should be allowed to move away from the group, all the students should move in a group and any deviation from this will be viewed seriously. Misbehaving students may be barred from participation.
- (d) When the children are escorted to the venues of different events, it is the personal responsibility of the escort teachers to periodically check the presence of all the students inside the premises of the venue vidyalaya. Escort teachers should take roll call of their wards wherever they are and the report will be given to the venue Principal. A suitable proforma may be made for this purpose.
- (e) All the participants should be clearly instructed that no indiscipline would be tolerated during the conduct of games and sports events. They should not get into any arguments with the umpires or the organizer of the events.
- (f) All the students as a whole should keep a watch on their personal belongings as well as the material of the vidyalaya being carried with them. Especially during transit from one mode of transport to another, the escort teachers should personally check the number of belongings.
- (g) The students should not be allowed to take any food from un-hygienic places. The escort teachers should carry required medicines to deal with any case of emergency.
- (h) It is advisable that all the children are made to deposit any personal cash with the escort teachers so that the same may be given to them after reaching the venue vidyalaya. The participants should be clearly instructed that they should abide by the rules and regulations fixed by the venue vidyalaya. No act of indiscipline should be condoned at any cost.
- (i) Under no circumstances the children should be allowed to go to any nearby water sources like ponds, lakes, canals etc.
- (j) It is advisable that the children are made to wear the school uniform during journey and during their stay in the venue vidyalaya, so that they can be easily identified. It is further advised that the contingent is divided into small groups of about 10 students and one leader is nominated to take care of each group. The escort teachers should periodically interact with these group leaders regarding the behaviour of the students. The escort teachers should make sure that all the children of the contingent know the correct address and the phone nos. of the venue vidyalaya so that it may be useful for them to contact in case of any emergency like missing. All students should be made to carry their identity cards with them through out the period of their stay outside their parent vidyalaya.

- (k) Venue Principals are advised to arrange for proper security of the students especially the girls. They may arrange for Police Bandobast, if required.
- (l) The venue Principals are advised to take the help of District Health Department for managing the sanitary and hygienic conditions in the vidyalaya when such a large number of the students are assembling in one place. Required emergency medicines can be procured in sufficient quantity and kept ready to meet any case of emergency.
- (m) A medical fitness certificate issued by a Govt. Medical Officer should be taken for all the students participating in Cluster//Regional/ National/SGFI.
- (n) Inoculation/vaccination or any such preventive medication may be done well in time in consultation with the Doctor.

To conclude, it is required that any lapse on our part in terms of safety & security measures will not only result in irreparable damage but also spoil the entire atmosphere in the vidyalaya.

➤ **T/DA OF PARTICIPANTS**

- i. TA/DA of escorts will be as per Samiti norms.
- ii. DA for the participants during journey only will be @Rs.150/- per day. Escort shall ensure that the participants are provided with the food instead of distributing the DA money to the participants and asking them to manage on their own.
- iii. While being in the venue vidyalaya during the games & sports meet, expenditure on food will be restricted to the usual norms determined by the venue vidyalaya in keeping with the Samiti norms.
- iv. During the coaching camp in particular the venue vidyalaya should ensure that the teams get good & balanced nourishment.
- v. The participants will arrive at the venue vidyalaya one day before the start of the meet.

➤ **CULTURAL ACTIVITIES**

A cultural evening may also be organized during the Cluster/Regional Meet. Each cluster may present items of folk song, folk dance etc. representing the cultural aspects of their region for about 15 minutes duration. Principals should ensure that good quality items are presented. But no musical instruments will be carried by the Games/Sports contingent.

➤ **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- i. Participants will carry School/Cluster/Regional Flag, light bedding, one tumbler, one plate, sports material and music instruments etc. as required by them.
- ii. Participants will be in white uniform for Cluster/Regional Meet. Participants will be in white uniform for Cluster/ Regional Meet.

Boys – White shirts, white shorts, white socks and White shoes. The Sikh students will wear white pataka.

Girls - White blouse, white skirt, white canvas shoes and white ribbon.

It is observed that some of the students are not wearing white uniform during March Past in such cases the action as deemed fit against the escort and PET of that vidyalaya will be initiated. The venue Principal is requested to kindly inform to RO if such cases are noticed.

All the participants should be in their prescribed track suits with white canvas shoes for March Past (National Meet)

iii. It is to be ensured that 'March Past' should be of high standard.

- The Principal will issue identity cards to the participating students of his/her school for Cluster/Regional Meets.

10. Certificate for National Sports Meet :-

This year Samiti has decided to make uniformity in the issuance of participating certificate for National Meet, the same would be issued jointly by concerned Deputy Commissioner and Commissioner, NVS. The Sample certificate is enclosed as Annexure B. However, the National venue may modify design as per requirement but it must be bilingual i.e. in Hindi & English. The Venue of National Principal is directed to forward the certificates through a messenger along with a singed copy of verified list of participants to Regional Office.

The certificate issued by NVS at Cluster, Regional & National Level the Serial Number should strictly be mentioned in the certificate.

11. Utilization of services of officials of Sports Authority of India

Samiti has decided to all the JNVs to explore the possibilities for feasibility of utilization of services of Coaches of SAI Centre for providing coaching in JNV Campus.

But as on date not a single vidyalaya has submitted any report for utilizing the service of SAI Coach. The Action taken report on this issue may be submitted to RO by 31st July 2018 positively.
